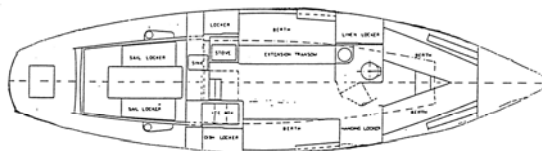


Circe

ACCOMMODATIONS

Circe has berths for five in two cabins. There is a V-berth forward with filler, and two transom berths and one pilot berth to port in the main salon. The head is equipped with a shower and hot & cold pressurized water. The galley is equipped with an icebox and a Force 10 three-burner propane stove with oven.

ELECTRONICS

Raymarine C-80 Chart Plotter/Radar (2008); Raytheon Nav 300 GPS with WAAS; Raytheon Tridata: speed, depth, and log; Raytheon windmeter (true/apparent); Icom VHF; Jensen AM/FM CD stereo and 12 volt outlet for cellular phone.

ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT

Hood roller furler for headsail, wheel steering, self-tailing winches, dodger, cockpit cushions and comfortable backrests, teak boarding ladder, screens, charcoal BBQ, and Avon (2008) with a 2½ h.p. four-stroke Yamaha outboard.

COMPLETE WITH

Linen (two sheets, one pillow case, two towels and a face cloth for each member of your party plus a dish towel and potholder), operating instructions, charts (complete Maine Coast), boating almanac, tide table, cruising guide, basic safety equipment, eating & cooking utensils, blankets & pillows, basic mechanical & navigational tools, fuel, water, and ice.

YOU BRING

Binoculars, foul weather gear (with hopes that you won't need it), warm clothes for sailing, t-shirts and shorts for sitting at anchor and exploring islands.
