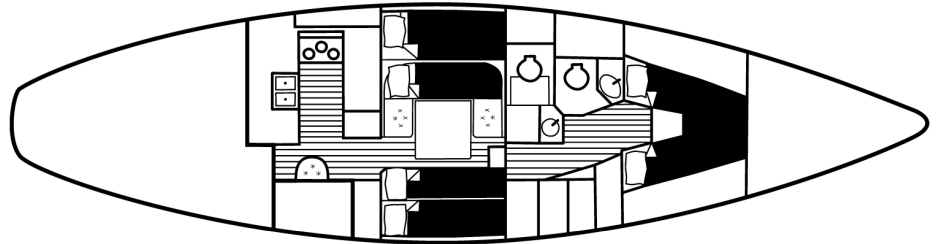

### ACCOMMODATIONS

*Cygnus* sleeps up to six with a spacious master cabin forward with an ensuite head. The main salon offers a multi-purpose area that may be used for dining, sleeping with four berths, and/or an entertainment center. A second head is located aft of the master head. There is a full sit-down navigation station. The galley features refrigeration with a separate freezer, a microwave, and a Shipmate three burner stove with oven

### ELECTRONICS

Furuno NavNet chartplotter/radar at helm; B & G sail instruments (wind, depth, & speed); Icom VHF; Autopilot; Westerbeke 12.5 Genset; CD/DVD player and FM; 110 outlets.

### ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT

Dodger; Electric self-tailing primary and secondary winches; Ideal windlass; boarding ladder; awning; propane BBQ; two Vacu-flush heads; air conditioner and heater with generator or shore power; Avon RIB with a 9.9 Yamaha.

### COMPLETE WITH

Linen (two sheets, one pillow case, two towels and a face cloth for each member of your party plus a dish towel and potholder), operating instructions, charts (complete Maine Coast), boating almanac, tide table, cruising guide, basic safety equipment, eating & cooking utensils, blankets & pillows, basic mechanical & navigational tools, fuel, water, and ice.

### YOU BRING

Binoculars, foul weather gear (with hopes that you won't need it), warm clothes for sailing, t-shirts and shorts for sitting at anchor and exploring islands.
