ACCOMMODATIONS

Fiesta sleeps six including a spacious owner's cabin aft with a double berth and single berth along with a private cockpit area. There is a v-berth for two in the forward cabin and a single berth in the main salon. There are two heads with showers and pressurized hot & cold water. The galley is equipped with a 3-burner propane stove with oven & broiler; a 2-burner electric stove; Amana microwave; refrigeration & freezer with icemaker.

Raytheon RL70C Pathfinder color radar with helm repeater; chartplotter/GPS at helm; Horizon VHF; Telcor wind direction and speed; Raymarine Depthfinder (2006); Panasonic flat TV; Sony stereo CD player with Bose speakers; 12 & 110 volt systems; 50/30 amp shore power; 12.5 kw Westerbeke Genset; and a Vetus bow thruster.

ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT

Profurl roller furler, electric windlass, reverse cycle air conditioning and heating system, Barient ST electric primary winches, cockpit cushions, dodger for both cockpits, boarding ladder, screens, propane BBQ grill, and inflatable dinghy with 3.5 Mercury outboard.
