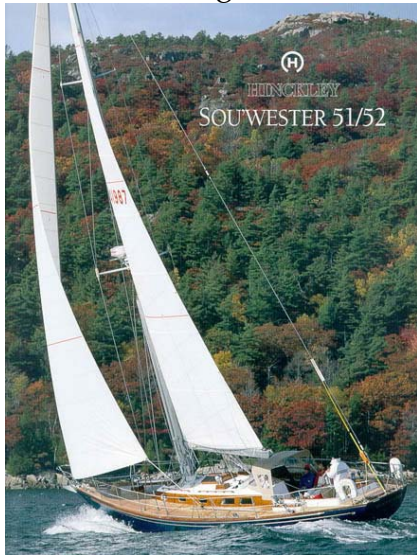

ACCOMMODATIONS

Lancer has sleeping accommodations for up to 7 in 3 cabins (including the main salon) and two heads each with a shower. There is a v-berth forward with cushioned insert to form a double berth with an ensuite head; the main cabin has two pilot (upper) berths port and starboard; two built in cushioned seats to starboard and a dinette to port; the aft stateroom has a double berth with an ensuite head. The galley is equipped with a three burner Force 10 stove with oven; Frigoboat refrigeration and freezer.

Ockam instruments: New Garmin high definition radar and three Garmin color chartplotters; AIS; GPS; Icom VHF (2008); SSB Sirius weather system; Television/DVD (2008); Sirius radio (2008); 12 volt and 110 volt system; and shore power.

Banmar electric roller furler; Stack pack for mainsail on ball bearings for ease of use; Gas BBQ grill; Electric winches; Electric windlass; shore power; Vacu-flush heads; Westerbeke 8 kw generator; Dodger (2009) and bimini; stereo; Edson wheel steering; cockpit table; teak decks, Autopilot; Brig inflatable with 15 hp Yamaha outboard.
