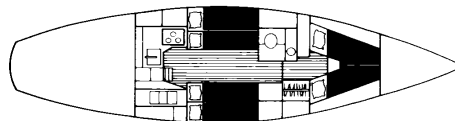


Ne Plus Ultra

Ne Plus Ultra is a vintage B-40 custom yawl that has been meticulously maintained and updated, combining the character of classic Hinckley styling with the convenience and safety of modern operating systems. She is a charm to behold, a pleasure to sail and decadence at anchor.



ACCOMMODATIONS

Ne Plus Ultra sleeps six in two cabins with a v-berth forward and two transom and two pilot berths in the main cabin. The head is equipped with a shower, a "Skipper" marine toilet, and custom lockers and drawers. The galley features a concealed microwave, a Force 10 range, and quiet, efficient engine driven refrigeration. The electrical system combines digital monitoring, an inverter/charger, shore power, and dual alternators with isolated battery banks to provide dependable 12v/110v power while sailing, at the dock, or at anchor.

ELECTRONICS

Raytheon RL 70 RC color radar/GPS moving map with local C-map at the helm with a second display at the nav station, Autohelm ST 60 depth, speed, and wind instrument in the cockpit with a multi-repeater at the nav station, SIMRAD12 autopilot, Standard VHF, ICOM handheld VHF, nav station tell-tale compass, AM/FM/CD with Bose speaker system with iPod adapter and MP3 player, 23" swivel-mounted LCD TV/DVD with antenna booster, a CD/DVD movie and music library, and several 12v/110v outlets for your cell phone and notebook computer.

Barient self-tailing winches, twin bow anchors/rollers with a new Maxwell electric windlass, Espar central heat, new cockpit cushions, cockpit table, engine and shore power heated water tank, boarding ladder, Avon inflatable with 9.9 outboard, dodger, propane BBQ grill, hatch screens, v-berth insert, oil lamps and halogen lighting, wine locker, all-clad cookware, and a soapstone HRH fireplace for warmth and romance.
