ACCOMMODATIONS

Rebecca has sleeping accommodations for up to seven in three cabins. There is a full width double in the Master stateroom forward with an ensuite head; the main cabin offers a U-shaped dining area with a single berth; to starboard is a settee that pulls out to form another single berth; the aft stateroom has a double berth with an ensuite head and there is a quarter berth aft of the navigation station. The galley is equipped with a three-burner Force 10 stove with oven; Grunnert refrigeration and a microwave. An Espar heater will keep you toasty on cool evenings.

Raymarine E-120 color chartplotter/radar on cabin top (2008); Raymarine E-80 plotter/radar (2008) and Garmin plotter at nav station; Sirius satellite weather and radio (2008); Raymarine ST-60 depth, speed, multi-data, and wind indicator; Raystar 125 GPS; Ray 230 VHF; Raymarine autopilot; cassette player, TV/ VCR and Alpine FM/CD player; 12 volt and 110 outlets.

ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT

Leisure Furl mainsail with electric winch to raise and reef main; Harken roller furling double slotted headstay; Hydraulic boom vang; Self-tailing winches; shore power; Muir electric windlass (2004); dodger; awning; cockpit cushions; cockpit table; Edson wheel steering; cedar lined hanging lockers; gas BBQ grill, screens, and rigid inflatable dinghy with 15 hp outboard.

Linen (two sheets, one pillow case, two towels and a face cloth for each member of your party plus a dish towel and potholder), operating instructions, charts (complete Maine Coast), boating almanac, tide table, cruising guide, basic safety equipment, eating & cooking utensils, blankets & pillows, basic mechanical & navigational tools, fuel, water, & ice.
