ACCOMMODATIONS

Requiescere sleeps six in two cabins. There is a v-berth forward, while in the main salon there is one transom and one pilot berth to starboard, and a dinette to port that converts to a double bed. The head is equipped with a shower and hot and cold pressurized water system. The galley had a three-burner propane stove with oven and a Grunert Refrigeration system.

ELECTRONICS

Raymarine E-80 radar and chartplotter (2007/2008) below and at helm; Datamarine Speed, knot log and depth; Icom-VHF; Alpine CD player with Ipod connection (2008); ACR EPIRB (2007); and a 12-v convenience plug in galley.

ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT

Hood roller furling, lazy jacks (2008); holding tank (2008); screens (hatch and overhead); inflatable Zodiac with 8 HP Yamaha 2 Cycle Outboard (2007); boarding ladder; zip extension to dodger for sun cover; and aft mainsheeting which provides for an unobstructed cockpit.

COMPLETE WITH

Linen (two sheets, one pillow case, two towels and a face cloth for each member of your party plus a dish towel and potholder), operating instructions, charts (complete Maine Coast), boating almanac, tide table, cruising guide, basic safety equipment, eating & cooking utensils, blankets & pillows, basic mechanical & navigational tools, fuel, water, and ice.

YOU BRING

Binoculars, foul weather gear (with hopes that you won't need it), warm clothes for sailing, tee shirts and shorts for sitting at anchor and exploring islands.
