ACCOMMODATIONS

Sialia has sleeping for up to six in two cabins. There is a double V-berth forward with filler, a dinette arrangement that converts to a double in the main cabin and one pilot and one transom berth. There is also a quarter berth aft of the nav station. There is one head with shower and pressurized hot and cold water. The galley is equipped with a three burner Shipmate stove with oven and Grunnert refrigeration.

Raymarine RL80C color radar/ chart plotter and Standard Horizon VHF in cockpit and at nav station; Raymarine autopilot; Raymarine ST-60 speed, depth, and wind instruments in cockpit; ST-60 Tri-Data and Multi-Data instruments at nav station; CD and cassette player with iPod adapter.
