The popularity of the Sou'wester 42 is unsurpassed and Mast Transit's aft cabin layout makes her ideal for those requiring the additional privacy of an aft-cabin.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Mast Transit has sleeping for up to seven in three cabins. There is a double V-berth forward with filler; a dinette arrangement to port that converts to a double; a settee to starboard in the main cabin and an aft cabin with a small double berth. There is one head with shower and pressurized hot and cold water. The galley is equipped with a three burner Force 10 stove with oven and Grunert refrigeration and freezer.

Ray Marine RL72 chartplotter & radar; Datamarine S200DL depth-sounder; Datamarine S100KL knotmeter; Icom VHF; wind instruments; Magnavox TV and VCR; Clarion radio/CD/tape player; and Robertson autopilot.
