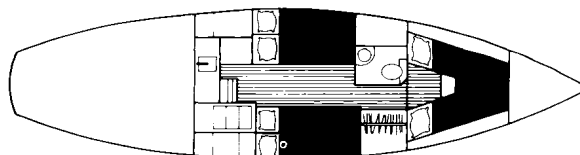

ACCOMMODATIONS

Osprey has berths for six in two cabins. There is a V-berth forward with filler, and two transom berths and two pilot berths in the main salon. The head is equipped with a shower and hot & cold pressurized water. The galley has an icebox and a three-burner stove with oven.

ELECTRONICS

Raytheon swing-out chartplotter (interfaced with GPS) with 10" color radar (2001), Garmin GPS, RDF, Kenwood VHF, Telcor knotmeter w/log, Sitex depthsounder, Telcor WDI & TPI, AM/FM radio.

ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT

Profurl roller furler for headsail, Lewmar ST primary winches, dodger, screens, cockpit cushions, boarding ladder, charcoal BBQ grill, and rowing dinghy.

COMPLETE WITH

Linen (two sheets, one pillow case, two towels and a face cloth for each member of your party plus a dish towel and potholder), operating instructions, charts (complete Maine Coast), boating almanac, tide table, cruising guide, basic safety equipment, eating & cooking utensils, blankets & pillows, basic mechanical & navigational tools, fuel, water, and ice.

YOU BRING

Binoculars, foul weather gear (with hopes that you won't need it), warm clothes for sailing, t-shirts and shorts for sitting at anchor and exploring islands.
