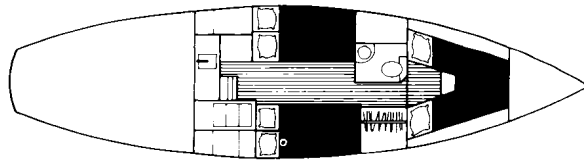

*Trillium is a completely restored classic Pilot. Her hull has been awlgripped Flag blue with a gold leaf name and hail. She also has a new mast, boom and standing rigging. All original hardware has been rechromed and her brass highly polished. Tiller steering enhances her traditional appeal.*



### ACCOMMODATIONS

*Trillium* has berths for six in two cabins. There is a V-berth forward and two transom and two pilot berths in the main salon. The head is equipped with a shower and hot & cold pressurized water. The galley is equipped with an icebox, 3 burner Force 10 propane stove with oven (2001). There is a Cole charcoal cabin heater for warmth.

### ELECTRONICS

Raymarine RL70C Plus Pathfinder radar and color chartplotter, 7" color LCD display (2002), Standard Horizon VHF, depthsounder (2005), speedo/log and a 12 volt outlet for cell phone hook-up.

### ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT

Roller furler (2005), Self-tailing primary winches (1998), new dodger, propane safety alarm, boarding ladder, tiller steering, self-tailing secondary winches (1999), Epirb (2002), and Dyer rowing dinghy or Inflatable with 4 hp Yamaha 4 stroke outboard.

### COMPLETE WITH

Linen (two sheets, one pillow case, two towels and a face cloth for each member of your party plus a dish towel and potholder), operating instructions, charts (complete Maine Coast), boating almanac, tide table, cruising guide, basic safety equipment, eating & cooking utensils, blankets & pillows, basic mechanical & navigational tools, fuel, water, and ice.

### YOU BRING

Binoculars, foul weather gear (with hopes that you won't need it), warm clothes for sailing, t-shirts and shorts for sitting at anchor and exploring islands.
